This week in the garden we have the following ready for picking:

South Garden

Beds 1 (west end), 4, and 5: Peppers (Hot and Sweet)

Beds 6,7, and 8: Tomatoes

Beds 9 and 11: Green Beans

Bed 10: Eggplant

Beds 16 and 17: Kale.

Trellis at the north end of Bed 14: Bitter Melon

Bed 18: Swiss Chard

Along the Edges of Many of the Beds: Green Onions.

East Garden

North Side of Squash Bed - Spaghetti Squash (Maybe if you are willing to sort through the vines)

Spread Throughout the Squash Bed - Butternut Squash
