Mr. Pat Berrigan, J.D. – an attorney who spent a good part of his career as Lead Trial Counsel for the Missouri Public Defender, defending persons throughout the state, charged with crimes for which the death penalty was sought. In that capacity he tried to a jury over 20 death penalty cases in state and federal court.

Dr. Nancy Seibolt – a retired Hospice and Palliative care physician whose expertise in end-of-life experiences will add insight into the dying process.

Fr. Chuck Tobin – a Diocesan priest will speak about the church's teaching on the sanctity of human life through the lens of Catholic Social Teaching.

A representative from Missourians for Alternatives to the Death Penalty will also be in attendance.
