- For those we judge to be “outsiders” who cannot be healed; and for the courage to know who are “foreigners” to us? *We pray,*
- For instruments of God’s healing: for doctors and nurses, therapists and counselors, researchers and spiritual guides, trusted friends and surprising people. *We pray,*
- For all in this community or among our loved ones in need of healing; for those who cannot articulate their pain; and for our own healing ministries in this Sacred Corner of the City and beyond. *We pray,*
- We pray now for our own concerns; and for the ability to persevere when personal pain overwhelms us (*Pause*). *For all these things, we pray.*
