- For this community, especially those whose needs we do not know; for those who struggle with their own responsiveness to the Gospel; and for the ongoing commitment to those whose needs we serve through our parish ministries. *We pray*,
- We pray now for our own needs and for the courage to explore whether our own actions reflect who we say we are and what we say we believe... (Pause). For all these things we pray,
