- For those places where there is conflict over food or water-- where food or clean water are made political weapons, especially in the developing climate crisis. *We pray,*
- For those among us who are sick, dying, grieving, or in any kind of need; and for those we feed in this sacred corner of the city and beyond through our parish ministries. *We pray,*
- We pray now for our own concerns and for the grace to understand how our hunger for the Eucharist compels us to feed others (*pause*). *For all these things, we pray,*
