READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2025,

THE SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT



First Reading - **Isaiah 11:1-10:** This passage foretells Jesus as a Spirit-filled ruler from David's line who will bring perfect justice, transform creation with peace, and draw all nations to God. **Reflection Question:** In what way does God's vision of righteous leadership and peace invite you to examine your hopes, values, and actions in a world longing for justice and harmony?

Second Reading - Romans 15:4-9: Scripture gives believers endurance and hope, calling them to live in unified love so that Jews and Gentiles alike may glorify God for His mercy.

Reflection Question: How does Paul's call for unity, endurance, and shared worship in this verse encourage you to extend grace and pursue harmony with others who differ from you?

Gospel - **Matthew 3:1-12**: John the Baptist calls people to repent as God's kingdom draws near and points to the greater One who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Reflection Question: How does John the Baptist's call to repentance and readiness in Matthew 3:1–12 invite you to realign your heart and actions with God's coming kingdom today?
