READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2025, THE FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT



First Reading - Isaiah 2:1-5: This passage envisions a future where all nations seek God's guidance, leading to peace, justice, and a world transformed by God's instruction.

Reflection Question: What is one practical way you can "walk in the light of the Lord" to promote peace in your daily relationships?

Second Reading - Romans 13:11-14: Believers are called to wake up spiritually, cast off behaviors of darkness, and live honorably by clothing themselves with Christ.

Reflection Question: What "works of darkness" might you need to let go of in order to live more fully in the light of Christ today?

Gospel - **Matthew 24:37-44**: Jesus' return will come unexpectedly, like the days of Noah, and urges believers to stay alert and ready.

Reflection Question: What does "being ready" for Christ's return look like in your everyday life right now?
